TELEWORK WHEN POSSIBLE

A memo was sent out to administrators explaining that they should avoid gatherings of staff and encourage telework during pedagogical days and any work that is not in presence of students that can be done at a distance.



COVID RAPID TESTS

As announced, the distribution of COVID-19 rapid screening tests is continuing. In our 3 regions where the risk of an outbreak is considered great, schools will receive these tests shortly. Administering the tests is **VOLUNTARY** and teachers do not have to volunteer. Training should also be provided for any volunteer who will administer the tests.
